

I HAVE NOW MOVED ON WITH MY LIFE

HAVING experienced a stormy relationship and having a constant reminder of that every day, Emma Bark decided to contact Barry, from Bellissimo-ne.

Emma, from East Herrington, called Barry after seeing his article in the Echo.

She said: "I read how he had helped people successfully remove unwanted tattoos.

"The reason for my interest in this procedure was because I had my ex-partners name tattooed on my body.

"Following a stormy relationship involving domestic violence, the tattoo was a constant reminder of the past, which I wanted to move on from.

"I was receiving support and advice from Vicim Support/Domestic Violence at the time and they also told me that Barry would be able to help."

Since Emma's first consultation with Barry, she has started to feel more positive.

She added: "I have now had my first treatment, which went very well, and the results are fantastic. You cannot make the name out anymore and I am looking forward to my next treatment.

"It has given me confidence in myself again and I have now moved on with my life."

Barry said it was an absolute pleasure helping Emma.

He said: "People can come to me without me asking any questions as it

takes all the confidence in the world to actually come to me in the first place. Like I have said so many times before, we are here to help."

Barry started off by offering free tattoo removals to people who are unemployed and can't

find work because of visible marks on their hands, neck and face.

His services are also extended to people who have been left scarred through tattoo removal treatment, victims of domestic violence who have a tattoo of their former partner's name and cancer patients left with a radiotherapy mark.

And now his wife, Michelle, offers permanent makeup free for people who are unemployed and looking for work, and who have suffered hair loss due to chemotherapy or alopecia.

Barry said: "We don't want people to sit in silence. They should contact us as we're happy to help."

Barry's wife Michelle is still offering the 50 per cent discount on permanent makeup procedures on eyes, brows and lips.

Barry added: "We would like to take this opportunity to say to the community of Wearside - if you need our help with any of our cosmetic procedures please contact us.

"We would also like to ask self-help groups for the young and old who either support the underprivileged who have visible tattoos, or groups that help alopecia or chemotherapy patients, to contact us so we can help further."

Michelle also provides scar camouflage, alongside mobile beauty treatments.

This was launched a few weeks ago and Michelle has treated ladies who have had scarring due to breast enhancements.

Barry said: "We can camouflage the scarring underneath the breast line to make the breast look as natural as

possible. This gives the result of a more natural looking breast rather than seeing the surgery scarring – and we have discounted the service to help during the credit crisis.

"We have had a couple of clients who have received genital plastic surgery. We can actually camouflage the scarring in these areas as well, and we also camouflage vitiligo.
